## ONE CHARACTER

(in total about 2500 basic root-words consisting of 2 or 3 characters)

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<b>ARAMAIC</b> from right to left	<b>ENGLISH</b> from left to right
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PRELIMINARY

### FOUNDATION:

THE FOUNDATION OF EACH WORD IS FORMED BY THE 22 CHARACTERS, AS FOLLOWS:

THE 22 BASE CHARACTERS :

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### WORDS

EACH ARAMAIC WORD CONSISTS OF A BASIS OF EITHER A THREE CHARACTER WORD , OR A TWO CHARACTER WORD, AND SOMETIMES A COMBINATION OF THESE.

TWO OR THREE CHARACTER WORDS :

HEREBY IS THE LAST CHARACTER THE MOST DETERMINING FACTOR

(AS ALSO IS THE CASE IN MANY LANGUAGE FOR ALL COMPOSED WORDS;

LIKE IN ENGLISH; TRAIN-STATION ( OPPOSED TO STATION-TRAIN, WHERE THE KIND OF TRAIN IS THE MAIN SUBJECT)

OR WITH; SUN-GLASSES (OPPOSED TO GLASS(ES)-SUN, WHERE SUN WOULD BE THE MAIN SUBJECT)

NOW, THE IDEA OF THE PRINCIPAL CHARACTER (IN ARAMAIC THE MOST LEFT),

IS DONE, IN THE WAY OF IDEA OF THE SECOND CHARACTER.

OR, IN OTHER WORDS;

DOING IDEA 1, IN THE FASHION OF IDEA 2.

### EXAMPLES

#### EXAMPLE 1

SO: IN CASE OF THE ARAMAIC WORD: **a h**

THIS MEANS THAN:

SO, DOING 'a', IN THE FASHION OF 'h' .

THAT IS TO SAY THAN:

THAT NAVIGATING IS DONE IN A 'LOOKING-WAY'.

WHICH MEANS: BEING AWARE OF WHAT IS GOING ON: IN OTHER WORDS: **look there**

#### EXAMPLE 2

AND IN THE INSTANCE OF THE ARAMAIC WORD : **a b c**

SO, DOING 'a', IN THE FASHION OF 'b' .

AND, DOING 'ab', IN THE FASHION OF 'c' .

NAVIGATING IN A 'HOUSING'-WAY, AND THIS TOGETHER IN A 'TRANSPORTING WAY'.

WHICH ALL TOGETHER MEANS: MAKING CHOISES . SO: **choose** .

as shown on following pages:

**ba**  
father

#### EXAMPLE 3

SO: THE ARAMAIC WORD : **b a**

THIS MEANS THAN:

SO, DOING 'b', IN THE FASHION OF 'a' .

THAT IS TO SAY THAN:

THAT HOUSING IS DONE IN A 'NAVIGATING-WAY'.

WHICH MEANS: TAKING CARE OF THE HOUSE AND THE HOME: IN OTHER WORDS: **father** .

**bTk**

#### EXAMPLE 4

AND IN THE INSTANCE OF THE ARAMAIC WORD : **b T k**

SO, DOING 'b', IN THE FASHION OF 'T' .

AND, DOING 'bT', IN THE FASHION OF 'k' .

HOUSING IN A 'FULFILLING'-WAY, WHICH MEANS ; **return**.

AND THIS RETURNING IN A 'FLY-ING' SO TO SAY HOOVERING OVER-WAY, WHICH DIRECTS TO DESCRIBING WHAT HAS HAPPENED,

WHICH IS MEANING: **write** .
